Research interests:

The research interests of the laboratory focus on two main areas:

1. Molecular Environmental Microbiology and Environmental Virology: Study of interactions between microorganisms and their hosts in different environments, molecular ecology of microbes and viruses, development of innovative methods for studying microorganisms, molecular detection and characterization of microbes and viruses in biological and environmental samples, laboratory investigation of microbial and viral evolutionary factors impacting public health and ecosystem health.

2. Microbial Ecology and Soil Microbiology: Soil microbial ecology, impact of environmental pollutants on the composition and function of soil microbial communities (environmental toxicology), control of microbial activities affecting geochemical processes - biogeochemical cycles (geomicrobiology), study of environmental fate and behavior of agrochemicals and other xenobiotic substances (environmental pollution).
